Bend Spay Neuter Program

Dogs: Drop off at 7:30 am, Pick-up at 4:00 pm

Cats: Drop off at 8:00 am, Pick-up at 5:00 pm

All appointments require \$25 non-refundable deposit. Deposit will be applied towards services.

Payment is due IN FULL at time of service.

Additional financial assistance is available for those in need. Please call for details.

We do not fill prescriptions or provide other medical services - we only provide the services listed below.

If your animal needs medical attention or is having an emergency, please call your vet or an emergency clinic.

Surgery Fees: *(Sept 2019)*

Male Dog Neuter: under 75lbs \$100 over 75lbs \$125

Female Dog Spay: under 75lbs \$125 over 75lbs \$150

Male Cat Neuter: \$50

Female Cat Spay: \$60

Mother/Kitten Special: \$100 (up to 4 kittens 4 months of age or younger. All cats must be brought in by ONE owner. Any additional kittens in the litter will be charged \$20 each for surgery.)

Feral/Community Cat Spay/Neuter: \$10
includes rabies vaccination and ear tip.

Pre-surgical bloodwork- \$60

Pre-surgical bloodwork is required for dogs 7 years and older, cats 10 years and older, and high-risk patients.

Additional charges (price by doctors discretion)

In Heat / Pregnant- \$25 - 75

Cryptorchid - undescended testicle \$10 - \$75

Umbilical Hernia—\$25 - \$45

All **community cats** must be brought in a live trap. If they are not, we will transfer them into traps and charge a \$5 transfer fee.

We have live traps for rent at our clinic. There is a \$35 deposit to rent a trap which will be returned to you upon return of the trap.

Additional Services at time of Spay or Neuter surgery:

For a little extra money, your animal can have vaccinations, microchipping, deworming, and toenail trims done while they are under anesthesia. If you are interested in these services please let us know when you check your animal in for surgery.

Microchip: \$25

Canine Toenail Trim: \$8

Dewormer: \$5-\$25

Vaccinations during surgery:

Cat Vaccines

FVRCP: \$20 (feline rhinotracheitis, calici virus, panleukopenia) Recommended for ALL cats.

FeLV: \$20 (Feline Leukemia-Recommended for outdoor cats, must be tested for Leukemia prior to vaccination.)

Rabies: \$20 Recommended for all cats, but especially outdoor cats.

Dog Vaccines

DHPP: \$20 (distemper, parainfluenza, hepatitis, parvovirus) Recommended for ALL dogs.

Rabies: \$20 rabies vaccinations are recommended for ALL dogs and mandatory for dog licensing.

Bordetella: \$20 (kennel cough-recommended for dogs taken to kennels, groomed, use doggie daycare or frequent dog parks.)

Canine Influenza Virus (CIV): \$30 (recommended for dogs taken to kennels, groomers, doggie daycare or dog parks.)

Additional charges for surgery may be applied for dogs and cats in heat or pregnant.

Additional charges for surgery may be applied for dogs or cats with retained testicles (cryptorchid) or hernia repairs.

We strongly encourage all owners to purchase an E-Collar (plastic cone) for \$10. Using an E-Collar post-surgery will help reduce the chances your dog will lick or chew at their incision causing potential complications. Return your used E-Collar for a \$5 refund!!!

All dogs are sent home with 3 days additional **pain medication** at no extra charge.
